Hello all!! Indiana fell to 7th in the nation in December. We reported 69 new/ re-enrolled members. I know the holiday season slowed a lot of us down. Now, it's time to get to work! Frankfort is at 6.2% Net Gain, Jeffersonville is at 0.9% Net Gain, Clinton is at 0.9% Net Gain, Plainfield is at 2.4% Net Gain, Monticello is at 1.0% Net Gain, Cedar Lake is even at 0.0% Net Gain, and Garrett is even at 0.0% Net Gain. There are still quite a few auxiliaries that are within 5 members of reaching Net Gain. As I write this, there are 117 applicants waiting to be initiated. We need to get those ladies in our organization. They MUST be initiated to be a member. Local secretaries, please make sure your local membership chairmen are reaching out to these candidates.
